HCA HISTORY

Highland Christian Academy was established in 1999 and currently serves over 200 students from Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 12. HCA sits on an 18-acre campus located in Valdosta, Georgia near Moody Air Force Base.

HCA is accredited through the Georgia Accrediting Commission and utilizes curriculum such as Abeka, ACSI, Bob Jones, and includes dual enrollment options through Wiregrass Technical College (on-campus), Georgia Military College, and Valdosta State University.
